

- For each upper body area (hand, wrist, or elbow) squeeze out 2.25 inches (2 grams)
- For each lower body area (foot, ankle, or knee) squeeze out 4.5 inches (4 grams)

This specialized formula helps the active ingredient, diclofenac, penetrate through the skin at the site of pain. When applied, Voltaren creates a cooling and moisturizing effect. | Can I use this with<br>other pain<br>medications?             | Ask your doctor or pharmacist before using Voltaren if you are taking any other pain reliever or are planning on taking any other pain reliever, especially prescription or nonprescription NSAIDs (aspirin, ibuprofen, naproxen, or others).   |  |
| Where should I use<br>Voltaren?                               | You can use Voltaren on up to 2 body areas at the same time. The areas can include a foot, ankle, knee, hand, wrist, and elbow. Voltaren has not been studied for the relief of arthritis pain in the shoulders, hips, and back.  |  |
| How long does<br>Voltaren take to work?                       | Voltaren contains an effective nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory medicine which is clinically proven to relieve arthritis joint pain.
